<input type="checkbox"/> Mask cleaning liquid and Save-A-Dive kit	<input type="checkbox"/> Photocopies of your passport, logbook, C card, travel and medical insurance, ID card.

<input type="checkbox"/> Booties	<input type="checkbox"/> Reef gloves
<input type="checkbox"/> BCD	<input type="checkbox"/> Wet suit/ dry suit
<input type="checkbox"/> Dive light + extra set of batteries and spare light	<input type="checkbox"/> Diving knife and sheath
<input type="checkbox"/> Swimsuit/ trunks and cover ups (shorts, tee-shirts, long sleeved shirts, trousers, sundresses, sarongs)	<input type="checkbox"/> Beach shoes/ flip flops / non slip shoes
<input type="checkbox"/> Beach towels	<input type="checkbox"/> Sun hats with a wide brim and chin strap (to protect yourself from the sun whilst you prepare your gear for the dive)
<input type="checkbox"/> Sweater, jacket, windbreaker (Ideal for boat trips)	<input type="checkbox"/> Ponchos or rain jackets (for unpredictable weather)
<input type="checkbox"/> Waterproof Sun screens and medicated creams for stings and jellyfish, bug spray, sunburn treatment, motion sickness medication	<input type="checkbox"/> Basic first aid kit

<input type="checkbox"/> Water proof plastic bags (to pack wet gear in luggage)	<input type="checkbox"/> Additional Fin straps, mask straps
<input type="checkbox"/> Float with flag	<input type="checkbox"/> Glow sticks
<input type="checkbox"/> O-rings	<input type="checkbox"/> Safety whistle (to be attached to BCD)
<input type="checkbox"/> Dive tables	<input type="checkbox"/> Underwater camera and casing, memory cards and spare batteries (for the avid photographer)
<input type="checkbox"/> Label suit case clearly and appropriately	<input type="checkbox"/> Secure with Travel Sentry Certified McNett® TSA Locks

<b>To be packed in the Hand Luggage:</b>
